Best iPhone Deal

iPhone SE from Apple (2020)

Despite its low price of \$400, the 2020 iPhone SE is equipped with the same A13 CPU as the previous year's top-of-the-line iPhone 11 Pro. As a result, the vast majority of programs and games will work flawlessly on your system. Those who like Apple's previous phones will be happy to know that this is the only iPhone available now with giant bezels, a home button, and Touch ID to unlock the device securely. Wireless charging and an excellent single-lens camera round out the current features. Unfortunately, the lack of a headphone jack is disappointing.

However, keep in mind that the camera quality, particularly in low light, will be inferior to successors like the iPhone 12 and 13 since there is no Night mode on this phone. Because of this, the battery only lasts roughly a full day with moderate usage, as senior reviewer Lauren Goode points out in her assessment of the device. This is the phone for you; in addition, since it is also a pocket-sized "small" phone, though not the smallest one around (that title now goes to the iPhone 13 Mini). Level Up With This Pick

Apple iPhone 13

The best iPhone for most people is the iPhone 13 (8/10, WIRED Recommends). As a result, the primary camera now has sensor-shift stabilization to compensate for unsteady hands, and the standard storage capacity has been increased from 64 gigabytes to 128 gigabytes. In addition, the 6.1-inch OLED display is precisely great in terms of size. Cinematic mode, which combines Portrait mode with video and blurs the background surrounding your subject, is one of the most excellent new features. It is, however, quite fussy. The cameras have become better and better in general. The wide-angle and ultra-wide-angle lenses can capture more light, resulting in more detailed and well-lit images when taken at night.

The A15 Bionic processor that powers it is no wimp either, with battery life easily lasting a full day and then some with intensive use. The only drawback is that the colors are mediocre at best. Waterproof to IP68, 5G enabled, and still compatible with the MagSafe attachment system from the previous model.

For Small Phone Lovers

Apple iPhone 13 Mini

Have a problem with oversized phones? This is the tiniest iPhone yet, and one of the smallest cellphones ever made. Even though the iPhone SE 2020 is physically smaller, Apple maintained the

contemporary iPhone design, including thin bezels around the screen and Face ID in place of Touch ID. As a result, the phone has a more prominent 5.4-inch OLED display than the iPhone SE 2020. Although it has the same capabilities as the iPhone 13, this model's battery life may be a little better. The Mini will keep the lights on until you go to bed, but you may need to carry a portable charger if you use it often.

Apple's Most Expensive Smartphone: The iPhone

Apple's iPhone 13 and 13 Plus models, as well as the larger iPhone 13 Plus

The iPhone 13 Pro and iPhone 13 Pro Max is worth at least \$1,000. Aluminum would have been used instead of this hybrid stainless steel/glass material, making it more robust. Those who require the largest possible display (and do not want an iPad Mini) will choose the Max because of its enormous 6.7-inch OLED screen. This year's 6.1-inch Pro boasts the same set of features as last year is, so going tiny won't leave you behind. With a 120-Hz refresh rate, using the screen seems more natural. It is also possible to improve the brightness of OLED panels while maintaining a battery life of at least a full day, if not longer, with intensive usage. For the first time, the more expensive models are outperformed by the more expensive ones. Compared to the iPhone 12 Pro from last year, the iPhone 12 Pro has an additional graphics core that helps demanding games operate more smoothly.

The 3X optical zoom camera is part of the triple camera system, and Night Mode is available on all of them. In low light, the photos taken by all three sensors will be crisper and brighter since they can take in more light. You may take a close-up photo of your dog's snout with the ultrawide camera, which also functions as a macro lens. Later this year, you will be able to record 4K video in ProRes format, which gives you more editing power over your movies. Just note that for the 4K video recording, you will need the 256GB model. The 1080p resolution is the only one available on the 128-GB variant. For those looking to save a few dollars, the non-Pro phones include many of the same capabilities as the Pro models.

The Mid-Range iPhone

Apple's iPhones are still fantastic.

There are three alternative iPhones from Apple this year if you do not want the most recent model but do not wish to purchase a used one. These three models are the iPhone 12, the iPhone 12 Mini, and the iPhone 11. I recommend the iPhone 13 Mini, which comes with two times the capacity and superior cameras and a modest improvement in battery life when it comes to the Mini. This latter element is critical since the battery life on the first Mini was appalling.

If the cost is less than \$800, then...

Apple iPhone 12 Pro and iPhone 12 Pro Max

Apple has scrapped the iPhone 12 Pro and iPhone 12 Pro Max until 2020, but you can still purchase them now. They feature powerful CPUs and three cameras on the back, so you can use the wide-angle lens to get a broader perspective or the telephoto lens to get a closer look. Everything on the phone is standard fare: stainless steel construction, superb OLED screens, all-day battery life, water resistance,

and even wireless charging.

The new iPhone 13 has a starting price of \$829, so do not go over that limit when purchasing a phone. If you are not interested in purchasing renewed from Amazon, it seems that most merchants no longer carry them. However, resale services like Swappa, where you may get new or pristine condition items, may be able to help you save some money.
